PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Hockessin DE DMS100 switch are associated with CLI code HCKSDEHCDS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Wilmington DE CS2K switch are associated with CLI code WLMGDEWLPS1 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Hockessin DE DMS100 switch, located at 1157 Old Lancaster Pike, Hockessin, DE 19707, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Wilmington DE CS2K switch, located at 901 North Tatnall Street, Wilmington, DE 19801. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Wilmington DE CS2K switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Hockessin DE DMS100 switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Wilmington DE CS2K switch.

All ASRs for the Wilmington DE CS2K switch must be received no later than March 27, 2023 to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the Hockessin DE DMS100 switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Hockessin DE DMS100 switch (**on or after May 1, 2023**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the three (3) native codes currently served by the Hockessin DE DMS100 switch to reflect the Wilmington DE CS2K switch as the new home switch. All ASRs for the Wilmington DE CS2K switch must carry the project code of **HCKSDEHCDS0**.
