PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Valley Falls, NY DMS10 switch are associated with CLI code VLFLNYVFDS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Albany, NY PEO switch are associated with CLI code ALBYNYSSPS1 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Valley Falls, NY DMS10 switch, located at 14 Charles Street, Valley Falls, NY 12185, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Albany, NY PEO switch, located at 158 State Street, Albany, NY 12207. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless, and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Albany, NY PEO switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Valley Falls, NY DMS10 switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Albany, NY PEO switch.

All ASRs for the Albany, NY PEO switch must be received no later than September 15, 2023 to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the Valley Falls, NY DMS10 switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Valley Falls, NY DMS10 switch (**on or after November 1, 2023**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the one (1) native code currently served by the Valley Falls, NY DMS10 switch to reflect the Albany, NY PEO switch as the new home switch. All ASRs for the Albany, NY PEO switch must carry the project code of **VLFLNYVFDS0**.
