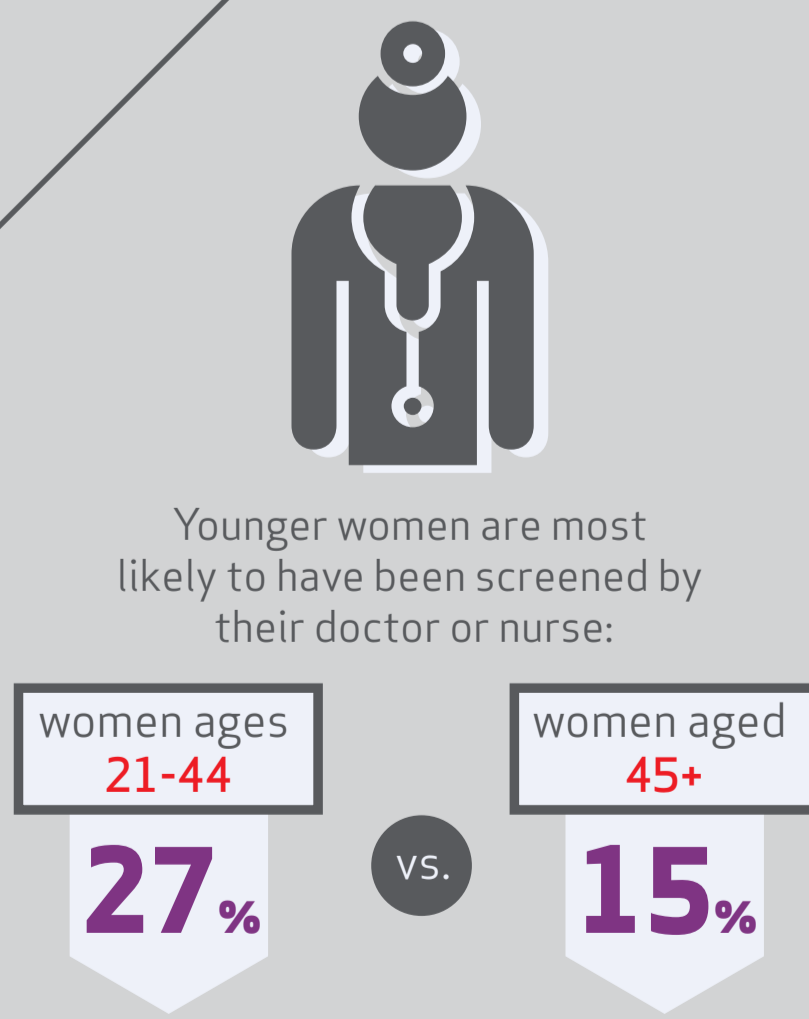
Dentists and dental hygienists are in a unique position to see soft tissue injuries inside a woman's mouth after she's been hit in the face or choked.
