**Description of the Planned Network Change(s):**

Verizon intends to retire the remaining copper facilities in all locations not previously retired or pending retirement in the following NY central offices: Freeport, Hempstead, Long Beach, and New Dorp. Verizon plans to deploy its fiber-to-the-home network in these areas and intends to provide services over a fiber network infrastructure.

**Description of reasonably foreseeable impact(s) of the planned change(s):**

After the retirement of the copper facilities, Verizon will: (1) no longer offer services over copper facilities; and (2) cease maintaining the copper facilities.
