

How is an unwanted robocall created?

1. A bad guy 🤡 creates a list of phone numbers.
2. They get their hands on cheap digital voice service. 🗣️
3. They craft an intriguing audio recording. You know the ones:
 Auto Warranties  Car Insurance
 Social Security  Health Care
4. They use software to auto-dial thousands - or MILLIONS! - of numbers in a short time so they can't easily be identified or blocked by carriers 🧑 (grumble).
5. If the victim returns a call it's directed to an operator (more bad guys) who tries to extract money or obtain sensitive information.


How does Verizon help protect our customers?

1. We auto block calls 🛑 identified as phone numbers that are invalid, malformed or from a curated list of "do not originate" numbers.
2. We've also created thousands of 'honeypots' or lines that are set up to identify and observe illegal robocall campaigns. 🔦
3. Once identified we work with law enforcement to take action. 🚔
4. With solutions like our Free Call Filter app/service we've helped MILLIONS of customers identify and avoid over 9 BILLION spam calls! 
5. We're working closely with other major carriers to exchange calls verified to be from the number displayed on the Caller ID.
