PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Bradley MD 5ESS switch are associated with CLI code BTHSMDBDDS0 and will not be repeated throughout the notice.

- All references to the Gaithersburg MD CS2K switch are associated with CLLI code GTBGMDGBPS0 and will not be repeated throughout the notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Bradley MD 5ESS switch, located at 7887 Bradley Boulevard, Bethesda, MD 20817, will be retired and removed from the Verizon network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Gaithersburg MD CS2K switch, located at 5 N, Frederick Avenue, Gaithersburg, MD 20877. All traffic to be migrated to the Gaithersburg MD CS2K switch includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC IXC), wireless and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

All carriers, including competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), Interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers, will need to provision new trunk groups to support direct end office trunking to the Gaithersburg MD CS2K switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented.

All ASRs for the Gaithersburg MD CS2K switch must be received no later than **September 10, 2026**, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Bradley MD 5ESS switch (**on or after September 30, 2026**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the NPA codes currently served by the Bradley MD 5ESS switch to reflect the Gaithersburg MD CS2K as the new home switch. All trunks to the Gaithersburg MD CS2K switch must be in place prior to the decommissioning of the Bradley MD 5ESS switch.
