PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Westbury NY DMS 100 switch are associated with CLI code WBYNNYWEDS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Deer Park NY CS2K switch are associated with CLI code DRPKNYDPPS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Westbury NY DMS 100 switch, located at 220 Maple Avenue, Westbury, NY 11590, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Deer Park NY CS2K switch, located at 85 W. 2nd Street, Deer Park, NY 11729. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless, and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Deer Park NY CS2K switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Westbury NY DMS 100 switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Deer Park NY CS2K switch.

All ASRs for the Deer Park NY CS2K switch must be received no later than May 15, 2026, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the Westbury NY DMS 100 switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Westbury NY DMS 100 switch (**on or after May 25, 2026**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the six (6) native codes currently served by the Westbury NY DMS 100 switch to reflect the Deer Park NY CS2K switch as the new home switch.
