

Verizon Federal, Inc.: Contract No. GS11T08BJD6001 (WITS 3)

- This WITS 3 contract modification extension is hereby executed and the period of performance is: three (3) years and one (1) day from the effective date of May 31, 2020, and not to exceed May 31, 2023; it is inclusive of a base period and two option periods as shown below:
  - May 31, 2020 - May 31, 2021            WITS 3 Extension Base Period
  - June 1, 2021 - May 31, 2022            WITS 3 Extension Option Period 1
  - June 1, 2022 - May 31, 2023            WITS 3 Extension Option Period 2
- Option Periods 1 and 2 may or may not be executed at the discretion of the government.
- The government has accepted Verizon's proposal, V14482.01, dated August 21, 2019 and revised proposal V14482.02, dated January 8, 2020 to include all terms and conditions and proposed pricing.
- Revised Section H.3(2) is incorporated in this contract modification extension.
- Incorporate FAR Provision 52.204-24 in full. (See page 3).
- Incorporate FAR Provision 52.204-26 in full. (See page 5).
- The Section I clauses revised and is incorporated in this contract modification extension.
- Verizon's approved Small Business Subcontracting Plan dated October 24, 2019, is incorporated in this contract modification extension.
- Verizon's Certifications and Representations in SAM dated September 6, 2019 through September 5, 2020 is incorporated into this contract modification extension.
- All other terms and conditions of the WITS 3 contract remain unchanged.

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## **52.204-24 Representation Regarding Certain Telecommunications and Video Surveillance Services or Equipment.**

As prescribed in [4.2105\(a\)](#), insert the following provision:

### REPRESENTATION REGARDING CERTAIN TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND VIDEO SURVEILLANCE SERVICES OR EQUIPMENT (DEC 2019)

The Offeror shall not complete the representation in this provision if the Offeror has represented that it “does not provide covered telecommunications equipment or services as a part of its offered products or services to the Government in the performance of any contract, subcontract, or other contractual instrument” in the provision at [52.204-26](#), Covered Telecommunications Equipment or Services-Representation, or in paragraph (v) of the provision at [52.212-3](#), Offeror Representations and Certifications-Commercial Items.

(a) *Definitions.* As used in this provision—

“Covered telecommunications equipment or services”, “critical technology”, and “substantial or essential component” have the meanings provided in clause [52.204-25](#), Prohibition on Contracting for Certain Telecommunications and Video Surveillance Services or Equipment.

(b) *Prohibition.* Section 889(a)(1)(A) of the John S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2019 (Pub. L. 115-232) prohibits the head of an executive agency on or after August 13, 2019, from procuring or obtaining, or extending or renewing a contract to procure or obtain, any equipment, system, or service that uses covered telecommunications equipment or services as a substantial or essential component of any system, or as critical technology as part of any system. Contractors are not prohibited from providing—

(1) A service that connects to the facilities of a third-party, such as backhaul, roaming, or interconnection arrangements; or

(2) Telecommunications equipment that cannot route or redirect user data traffic or permit visibility into any user data or packets that such equipment transmits or otherwise handles.

(c) *Procedures.* The Offeror shall review the list of excluded parties in the System for Award Management (SAM) (<https://www.sam.gov>) for entities excluded from receiving federal awards for “covered telecommunications equipment or services”.

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(d) *Representation.* The Offeror represents that it  will,  will not provide covered telecommunications equipment or services to the Government in the performance of any contract, subcontract or other contractual instrument resulting from this solicitation.

(e) *Disclosures.* If the Offeror has represented in paragraph (d) of this provision that it “will” provide covered telecommunications equipment or services”, the Offeror shall provide the following information as part of the offer—

(1) A description of all covered telecommunications equipment and services offered (include brand; model number, such as original equipment manufacturer (OEM) number, manufacturer part number, or wholesaler number; and item description, as applicable);

(2) Explanation of the proposed use of covered telecommunications equipment and services and any factors relevant to determining if such use would be permissible under the prohibition in paragraph (b) of this provision;

(3) For services, the entity providing the covered telecommunications services (include entity name, unique entity identifier, and Commercial and Government Entity (CAGE) code, if known); and

(4) For equipment, the entity that produced the covered telecommunications equipment (include entity name, unique entity identifier, CAGE code, and whether the entity was the OEM or a distributor, if known).

**52.204-26 Covered Telecommunications Equipment or Services-Representation.**

As prescribed in [4.2105\(c\)](#), insert the following provision:

COVERED TELECOMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT OR SERVICES-REPRESENTATION (DEC 2019)

(a) *Definitions.* As used in this provision, “covered telecommunications equipment or services” has the meaning provided in the clause [52.204-25](#), Prohibition on Contracting for Certain Telecommunications and Video Surveillance Services or Equipment.

(b) *Procedures.* The Offeror shall review the list of excluded parties in the System for Award Management (SAM) (<https://www.sam.gov>) for entities excluded from receiving federal awards for “covered telecommunications equipment or services”.

(c) *Representation.* The Offeror represents that it  does,  does not provide covered telecommunications equipment or services as a part of its offered products or services to the Government in the performance of any contract, subcontract, or other contractual instrument.
