January 2024 Release Upgrade

The release upgrade of the Verizon Partner Solutions Exchange platform is on Sunday, January 29, 2024. This release involves a technology change to the platform, along with incorporating enhancements to streamline the portal user experience. There are also changes to existing functionality and the support of products and features.

General Navigation

- **Dashboard and Hamburger menu** options presented will be based on the role(s) assigned to your login ID (quoting, ordering, repair, billing, etc.).
- **Dashboard widgets** will be displayed with a default set after you log in. Customization of the dashboard widgets is available for Quick Links & Application Links.

Dashboard Improvements

New widgets and links that are configurable.

- **Quick Lists** - Flagged Worklist transactions
- **Quick Links** - Start a transaction: Quote, Order, Repair
- **Application Links** - Access up to 6 Legacy Applications from your Dashboard

Hamburger Menu Redesigned

The options presented will be based on your assigned role.

Two new options were added due to the elimination of the start button and product catalog tiles:

- **Shop**
- **Network Management**

System Messages Simplified

- **Toast messages** present Information and notifications at the top of the screen for a brief time
- **Pop-up messages** will be presented if user action is required
- **Fields with errors** will be highlighted along with a message

Quoting

The multi-location quoting framework is the standard for all products.

- This is used to submit requests for one or more locations
- The single-quote journey is eliminated.

Ordering

Process Enhancements

- **Due Date Change** is a new supp order option to make date change without editing the order. Edit Order is used for other changes.
- **Autosaving during order entry** will allow going back and forward using the new progress bar and resume order entry.

Billing

All existing functionality is supported.

Repair

All existing functionality is supported.

Maps

Worklist and download functionalities remain the same.
