Fact: No public radio spectrum, whether it's the band used by Verizon Frontline or another carrier, is dedicated exclusively to public safety.

Different carriers use different slices of the commercial 700 MHz band of radio spectrum to support public safety communications. Congestion on cellular networks can potentially limit call completion rates for public safety, national security, emergency preparedness and critical

infrastructure personnel—which can potentially impact operational effectiveness. Verizon Frontline prioritizes first-responder communications so that their critical communications have a greater chance of call completion in the event of an emergency.

Our virtual core is designed to deliver emerging technologies as they become available, so first responders don't have to wait for lengthy network hardware upgrades.


