Subject : Verizon Partner Solutions Industry Letter: Selden, NY DMS 100 Switch Retirement

PLEASE NOTE:

All references to the Selden, NY DMS 100 switch are associated with CLLI code **SLDNNYSEDS0** and will not be repeated throughout this letter.

All references to the Deer Park, NY CS2K switch are associated with CLLI code **DRPKNYDPPS0** and will not be repeated throughout this letter.

As set out in the Verizon New York Inc. Short Term Public Notice Under Rule 51.333(a), dated August 31, 2026, on or after October 28, 2026, the Selden, NY DMS 100 switch will be retired and removed from the Verizon network as part of ongoing efforts to modernize the network.

General Information: The Exchange Codes (NXXs) in Numbering Plan Area (NPA) 631 currently residing in the Selden, NY DMS 100 switch (see list in Table B below) will be moved to the Deer Park, NY CS2K switch (see details in Table A below). The native NPA NXXs belonging to the Selden NY, DMS 100 switch will be rehomed upon decommissioning of the switch and reflected in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) for the Deer Park, NY CS2K switch. This will occur on or after October 28, 2026.

Network Changes and Trunk Rearrangements:

The Deer Park CS2K switch will be the recipient office of traffic migrated from the Selden, NY DMS 100 switch. Traffic bound for the codes listed in Table B will be delivered via the BRWDNYBWGT0 Deerpark DPG0T Tandem (DRPKNYDPG0T intra-lata SHA / DRPKNYDPG0T inter-lata FG Access SHA).

After all traffic is migrated off the Selden, NY DMS 100 switch, this switch will be retired and removed from the network.

CLECs, IXCs, IECs, wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Deer Park, NY CS2K switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that have direct end office trunk (DEOT) with access connectivity in the Selden, NY DMS 100 switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Deer Park, NY CS2K switch.

All ASRs for the Deer Park, NY CS2K switch must be received no later than September 30, 2026, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. All traffic must be moved by October 28, 2026.

Please adhere to industry standards using normal procedures that pertain to updates and changes to the LERG for all NXXs

subject to the retirement of the Selden, NY DMS 100 switch.
