Equalizer Menu	If you want to use FX on your mix track. Only "Filter Sweep" is available. To add Filter Sweep, press and move the control circle through the four zones to change the sound of your track. Zones consist of combinations from low to high and from strong to soft. Undo or delete FX by pressing the icons at the right of the screen.
