



Music Mixing

Reference Chart for Music Maker JAM



Use...	To...	Example...
Three Bars icon	<p>Open menu to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Select “Untitled Song” to name a project.• Save a project.• (Make a) new project.	
Plus sign (+) icon	<p>Add a new track and select its attributes by swiping left and right on a selection menu:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Genre (Digital Pop or Radio Rock).• Instrument or Vocals (Electric Guitar, Keyboard, Drums, and others).	


	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Style (variations of the selected instrument). 	
<p>Play and Pause buttons</p>	<p>Press the Play button to play your mix track.</p> <p>Press the Pause button to stop it playing.</p>	
<p>Activate or Mute Track toggle</p>	<p>Once created, click the track's name to make the track active (hear it play) or mute it (to temporarily turn off). Blue indicates active tracks and black indicates muted tracks.</p>	

<p>Make Music Menu and Volume Sliders</p>	<p>Volume Sliders – drag one up and down on any loop to adjust individual volumes.</p>

<p>Equalizer Menu</p>	<p>If you want to use FX on your mix track. Only “Filter Sweep” is available.</p> <p>To add Filter Sweep, press and move the control circle through the four zones to change the sound of your track.</p> <p>Zones consist of combinations from low to high and from strong to soft.</p> <p>Undo or delete FX by pressing the icons at the right of the screen.</p>

<p>Chord Menu</p>	<p>If desired, select a measure, which is a group of notes, (in the top row) and press a new key for the measure.</p>

	<p>Sharp (#) or flat (b) keys give your music a different feel.</p>	
<p>Master Volume and Metronome toggle (right side of screen)</p>	<p>Use the Master Volume slider to control the volume of the mix track.</p> <p>Toggle the icon to use the Metronome and set the number of beats per minute in your track by sliding up and down through the numbers.</p>	
<p>Record Menu (for recording acoustic sound to make a loop)</p>	<p>Record and add your own vocals, acoustic music, or sound effects at the Record Menu.</p> <p>Just press the microphone on a new loop.</p> <p>Following a short countdown, record your loop. A blue circle indicates you are recording.</p>	

	<p>You can select any sound you have previously recorded by clicking on the loop name and selecting a loop from your Record folder.</p>	
<p>Record a mix track</p>	<p>Record your entire mix track by pressing the red Record button.</p> <p>Press the button again to stop recording.</p>	
<p>Share a mix track</p>	<p>After recording a track, you are prompted to share your track.</p> <p>Follow the prompts to add cover art, a title, and a description to your track.</p> <p>Then indicate the venue where you want to share your mix track. Options include social media platforms and More.</p>
