

SECTION 5 - CUSTOMER EQUIPMENT AND CHANNELS (Cont.)

3. Coin-operated telephone equipment may be attached to services provided under the tariffs of MCImetro subject to Part 68 of the FCC Rules and subject to any applicable provisions of the tariffs of MCImetro.
4. MCImetro is not responsible for malfunctions of Customer-owned telephone sets or other Customer-provided equipment, or for misdirected calls, disconnects or other service problems caused by the use of Customer-owned equipment.

5.3 Interconnection of Facilities

1. Any special interface equipment necessary to achieve compatibility between the facilities and equipment of MCImetro used for furnishing Communications Services and the channels, facilities, or equipment of others shall be provided at the Customer's expense.
2. Communications Services may be connected to the services or facilities of other communications carriers only when authorized by, and in accordance with, the terms and conditions of the tariffs of the other communications carriers which are applicable to such connections.
3. Facilities furnished under the tariffs of MCImetro may be connected to customer provided terminal equipment in accordance with the provisions of the tariffs of MCImetro. All such terminal equipment shall be registered by the Federal Communications Commission pursuant to Part 68 of Title 47, Code of Federal Regulations; and all User provided wiring shall be installed and maintained in compliance with those regulations.

SECTION 5 - CUSTOMER EQUIPMENT AND CHANNELS (Cont.)

5.4 Inspections

1. Upon suitable notification to the Customer, and at a reasonable time, MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC may make such tests and inspections as may be necessary to determine that the Customer is complying with the requirements set forth in section 5.2.2 for the installation, operation, and maintenance of Customer-provided facilities, equipment, and wiring in the connection of Customer-provided facilities and equipment to MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC owned facilities and equipment.
2. If the protective requirements for Customer-provided equipment are not being complied with, MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC may take such action as it deems necessary to protect its facilities, equipment, and personnel. MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC will notify the Customer promptly if there is any need for further corrective action. Within ten days of receiving this notice, the Customer must take this corrective action and notify MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC of the action taken. If the Customer fails to do this, MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC may take whatever additional action is deemed necessary, including the suspension of service, to protect its facilities, equipment and personnel from harm.

SECTION 6 - PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS

6.1 Payment for Service

The Customer is responsible for the payment of all charges for facilities and services furnished by MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC to the Customer and to all Users authorized by the Customer, regardless of whether those services are used by the Customer itself or are resold to or shared with other persons.

6.2 Billing and Collection of Charges

1. Non-recurring, charges are due and payable within 2-5 days after the date an invoice is mailed to the Customer by MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC.
